



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
**Positive Characteristics of Map A:**

- Downtown Intact (D5)
- LGBT “Core” area intact
- LGBT Equality CA – mostly intact (D5/D3/D4)
- Valley View Acres attached to North Natomas
- River Oaks intact (D5)
- East Sac/River Park intact (D3)
- Latino North mostly intact (D2)
- Latino South mostly intact (D6)
- Del Paso Heights intact (D2)
- Oak Park intact (D6)
- Meadowview intact

**Weaknesses & Trade-Offs of Map A:**

- Oak Park in D6 instead of D5
- Oak Park in different district from Curtis Park
- South Natomas split (D2/D5)





## Positive Characteristics of Map B:


- Downtown Intact (D3)
- LGBT “Core” area intact
- LGBT Equality CA – mostly intact (D5/D3/D4)
- Valley View Acres attached to North Natomas
- **River Oaks intact (D4)**
- East Sac/River Park Intact (D3)
- Latino North mostly intact (D4)
- Latino South mostly intact (D6)
- DPH intact (D2)
- Oak Park mostly intact (D6)
- Meadowview intact (D8)

## Weaknesses & Trade-Offs of Map B:

- Oak Park split (D5/D6)
- **Population deviation approximately 10%**
- **River Oaks split (D1/D4)**
- College Glen and Sierra Oaks in D2 (not D6)
- Center Parkway as the dividing line for D7/D8

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
### Positive Characteristics of Map C:

- LGBT “Core” area mostly intact
- LGBT Equality CA – mostly intact (D5/D3/D4)
- Valley View Acres attached to North Natomas
- Latino North mostly intact (D2/D3)
- Del Paso Heights intact (D2)
- Latino South mostly intact (D6)
- Oak Park intact (D5)
- Meadowview intact (D8)

### Weaknesses & Trade-Offs of Map C:

- River District & Railyards detached from Central City (D3)
- River Oaks split (D1/D2)
- East Sac/River Park split (D3/D5/D6)
- Colonial Heights removed from D6
- Tahoe Park split (D5/D6)





## Positive Characteristics of Map D:

- Downtown Intact (D<sub>4</sub>)
- LGBT "Core" area intact
- LGBT Equality CA – mostly intact (D<sub>4</sub>/D<sub>3</sub>/D<sub>5</sub>)
- Valley View Acres attached to North Natomas
- **River Oaks intact (D<sub>4</sub>)**
- East Sac/River Park intact (D<sub>3</sub>)
- Latino N mostly intact (D<sub>4</sub>)
- Del Paso Heights intact (D<sub>2</sub>)
- Latino South mostly intact (D<sub>5</sub>/D<sub>6</sub>)
- Oak Park intact (D<sub>5</sub>)
- Meadowview mostly intact (D<sub>8</sub>/D<sub>5</sub>)




## Weaknesses & Trade-Offs of Map D:

- Keeping Meadowview intact, split Greenhaven (consistent with existing district boundary lines)
- Trade-off between keeping Del Paso Heights intact & dividing surrounding neighborhoods
- **River Oaks split (D<sub>1</sub>/D<sub>4</sub>)**



# Modifications for Final Plans B, C, and D

**Substantive:** Plans B, C, D adjusted to better address ROCA's concerns: Remove both Willow Creek and Metro Center from D1



Map B, total deviation 8.4% (up from 6.7%)

Map C, total deviation 7.75% (up from 4.74%)

Map D, total deviation 9.69% (up from 7.99%)
