




 Retain the Current Midtown Neighborhood Preservation Transportation Program (NPTP)

As residents of Sacramento, we support the position of the Boulevard Park Neighborhood Association and others to retain the Neighborhood Preservation Transportation Plan's (NPTP) current traffic calming measures that have been in place and working for the last 7 years. Accordingly, we urge you to oppose the proposed changes to the H Street diverter at 21st Street and the G Street diverter at 20th Street that would direct additional traffic into the neighborhood.

The City Council's foresight in adopting the NPTP has resulted in the rejuvenation of several neighborhoods, made streets safer for pedestrians and bicyclists, and encouraged commuters to use arterial streets as they seek to access the freeways as intended by the City Council. The proposal to allow a left turn onto 21st Street at H and the move of the G Street diverter would reverse many of the gains the City has achieved with the NPTP. We urge you to keep the streets safe by disapproving these changes. Thank you.
