

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-107

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 26, 2008

APPROVING A CONTRACT: NORTH NATOMAS REGIONAL PARK PHASE 2 (LX66, L19140000)

BACKGROUND:

- A. North Natomas Regional Park is a 206.75-acre regional park located in North Natomas near North Park Drive whose master plan was approved by City Council on March 20, 2001.
- B. The City Council approved funding for the development and construction for North Natomas Regional Park, LX66, in the FY2005/06 Capital Improvement Program.
- C. City Code Chapter 3.60 identifies the general guidelines for completing contracts for public projects and procedures for bidding and issuing contracts over \$100,000.
- D. The formal bid process for the North Natomas Regional Park Phase 2 project has been completed based on the qualifications set forth by the City.
- E. Pursuant to City Code Section 3.60.020, it was determined that Hemington Landscape was the responsible, low bidder with the base bid of \$1,087,592. Additive alternatives will not be added to the contract; the total contract amount will be \$1,087,592.
- F. There are sufficient funds in North Natomas Regional Park Phase 2, CIP LX66, to award the contract.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract for the North Natomas Regional Park Phase 2, LX66 (L19140000), is approved.
- Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to execute and award the contract with Hemington Landscape for an amount not to exceed \$1,087,592 for North Natomas Regional Park Phase 2, LX66 (L19140000).


