

● Richards Blvd. on-ramp to SB I-5 closed


● I St. on-ramp to SB I-5 closed

Learn how fixing Interstate 5's "Boat Section" will affect your commute.


Starting soon, a project to fix Interstate 5 between R Street and Richards Blvd. will be underway and you will encounter daily lane and ramp closures.
