AUTHORIZING ACTIONS RELATED TO CONSTRUCTION OF THE OAK PARK COMMUNITY CENTER - PHASE II PROJECT (KB29, L13000100)

BACKGROUND

- A. On March 29, 2005, City Council established the Oak Park Community Center – Phase II Project.
- B. The formal bid process for the construction of the Oak Park Community Center – Phase II Project was completed on February 27, 2008. John F. Otto was determined to be the lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The construction plans and specifications for the Oak Park Community Center - Phase II Project are approved.
- Section 2. John F. Otto is awarded the construction contract for the Oak Park Community Center – Phase II Project in an amount not to exceed \$2,444,222.
- Section 3. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the construction contract specified above.


