REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR INTEROPERABILITY EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES FOR THE SACRAMENTO REGIONAL RADIO COMMUNICATION SYSTEM (SRRCS)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Federal Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) provides funding to law enforcement agencies for public safety purposes. The COPS office has allocated \$5.7 million in funding for a 3-year grant to upgrade 800 MHz radio interoperability in the Sacramento region. The City Council, by Resolution 2007-872, authorized acceptance of this grant funding.
- B. The County of Sacramento, Office of Communication and Information Technology, maintains and operates the Sacramento Regional Radio Communications System (SRRCS), which is the radio system utilized by City of Sacramento public safety departments.
- C. The County of Sacramento will contract for SRRCS services and equipment in accordance with the COPS grant guidelines, and will seek from the Sacramento Police Department reimbursement with COPS grant funds.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or designated representative, is hereby authorized to execute the attached agreement with the County of Sacramento (County) to reimburse the County for expenditures made for Sacramento Regional Radio Communications System services and equipment.




