**AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR SLUICE FLOOD GATE REPLACEMENT
AT BLUE DIAMOND ALMOND GROWERS
(PN: XN33, X14010012)**

BACKGROUND


- A. The two flood gates are located in two major combined sewer lines at the Blue Diamond Almond Growers facility and are used to isolate floodwaters that otherwise flow from the north and exacerbate flooding of the downtown area during a flooding event. The gates are broken and need to be replaced.
- B. City staff prepared the plans and contract specifications to replace two flood gates and to rehabilitate the existing structures housing the flood gates. The project was advertised for bidding and received six (6) bids on May 14, 2008. The low bidder did not meet the ESBE participation requirement rendering its bid non-responsive, as provided in Sacramento City Code section 3.60.270. T&S Construction was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the Sluice Flood Gate Replacement at Blue Diamond Almond Growers project (PN: XN33, X14010012) are approved, and the construction contract is awarded to T&S Construction for an amount not to exceed \$156,330.
