**AUTHORIZE AGREEMENT FOR THE STATE TRADE
CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT FUNDS (CF48 / T15029005)**

BACKGROUND

- A. The City was awarded \$20 million in State Trade Corridor Improvement Funds (TCIF) toward track relocation. An agreement needs to be established with the California Transportation Commission and California Department of Transportation for programming those funds.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute various Agreements as required with the California Transportation Commission and California Department of Transportation to allocate Trade Corridor Improvement Funds (TCIF) funds (Fund 512 / 3704) to the Track Relocation project (CF48 / T15029005).
- Section 2. The City will provide for matching funding for the project through pursuit of federal funds and dedication of Measure A local funds to address the balance of funding as needed.


