

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2008-499**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 22, 2008

**AUTHORIZING ONE OR MORE MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL TO SUBMIT THE COUNCIL'S WRITTEN ARGUMENT IN FAVOR OF PROPOSED CHANGES IN CHAPTER 3.32 OF THE SACRAMENTO CITY CODE (THE UTILITY USER TAX) TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS AT THE CONSOLIDATED ELECTION ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 4, 2008**

### **BACKGROUND**

- A. On July 22, 2008, the City Council adopted a resolution ordering that proposed changes in chapter 3.32 of the Sacramento City Code (the utility user tax) be submitted to the voters at the consolidated election on November 4, 2008.
- B. The City Council desires to submit an argument for inclusion in the official sample ballot.

### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Mayor Fargo and Vice Mayor Cohn to file a written argument **in favor of** the measure.
- Section 2. The argument is to be prepared in accordance with the California Elections Code and the Election Official's printing guidelines.
- Section 3. The City Council hereby directs the City Clerk to certify the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


Adopted by the City of Sacramento City Council on July 22, 2008 by the following vote:
