

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-502

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 22, 2008

AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE AND GIFT OF WORKS OF ART TO BE ACQUIRED BY THE CITY

BACKGROUND

- A. The Convention, Culture, and Leisure Department was notified by the City Attorney's Office that neither the City Code nor Administrative Policy Instructions give authority to the City Manager to execute agreements for the purchase or gift of works of art because these transactions do not fall within definition of non-professional or professional services, the purchase of goods, or public projects.
- B. Consistent with the City and County Codes, City Public Art Policy, and Standard Operating Procedures, artworks will be reviewed and approved by SMAC before being authorized for purchase or receipt.
- C. The City Manager's authority to approve the purchase, and gift, of works of art under \$100,000 will increase the ability of staff to expedite contracts quickly and efficiently.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to approve and execute agreements on behalf of the City for the purchase or gift of works of art in amounts less than \$100,000.


