**ACCEPTANCE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL (ABC) LIAISON OFFICER GRANT**

**BACKGROUND**

A. The City of Sacramento has received a \$100,000 grant funded through the Grant Assistance to Law Enforcement, and administered by the California Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) for the FY09 Sacramento Police Department’s ABC Liaison Officer Program.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to accept a grant award on behalf of the City of Sacramento, from the California State Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control, which totals \$100,000, including any future extensions, agreements, modifications or attachments thereof.

Section 2. The grant shall be used to sustain the current ABC Liaison Officer Program for an additional one-year period. At the end of the grant period, if no funding sources are available, the program will be terminated, and the Police Department’s staffing will be reduced by 1.0 FTE.

Section 3. The Grant Operating Expense and Revenue Budgets shall be amended as follows:


