APPROVING THE ROBERTSON PARK MASTER PLAN CHANGE

BACKGROUND

- A. Robertson Park is an existing 9.18-acre community park located in North Sacramento. The change to Robertson Park Master Plan was reviewed and supported by the Parks and Recreation Commission on May 1, 2008.
- B. The Environmental Services Manager has reviewed the project for compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined that the project is exempt under Section Number 15302 and 15303.
- C. Pursuant to Guidelines section 15091(e), the documents and other materials that constitute the record of proceedings upon which the City Council has based its decision are located in and may be obtained from, the Office of the City Clerk at 915 I Street, Sacramento, California. The City Clerk is the custodian of records for all matters before the City Council.
- D. Long-term designs of public facilities are reviewed and approved by City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The changes to Robertson Park Master Plan are approved.






