

**RESOLUTION NO. 2008-614**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

September 9, 2008

**AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE CHANGE ORDER NO. 4 TO CONTRACT NOS. 2006-057 AND 2006-058 IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$95,000 PER CONTRACT FOR HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SERVICES**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. On December 2, 2003, City Council adopted Resolution No. 2003-853, approving the Smith Culp Consultant Study recommendations to improve the delivery of projects. One of the recommendations was to establish on-call contracts for cost effective and efficient delivery of contractor services.
- B. On March 14, 2006, contracts were awarded to Parc Specialty Contractors, and Allied Environmental, Inc. for \$95,000 each for on-call hazardous materials services.
- C. Change Order Nos. 1-3 were for time extensions only and involved no additional funding. Change Order No. 3 extended the time of performance to June 30, 2009 for each contract.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute Change Order No. 4 with Parc Specialty Contractors in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 bringing the total contract amount to \$190,000.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute Change Order No. 4 with Allied Environmental, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$95,000 bringing the total contract amount to \$190,000.
- Section 3. The City Manager's signature authority is reset.


