Recognizing the 25th Anniversary of the University of Northern California, Lorenzo Patiño School of Law & Commending the Late Honorable Judge Lorenzo E. Patiño

WHEREAS, the University of Northern California, Lorenzo Patiño School of Law and Paralegal (UNC), incorporated on September 30, 1982, was established to provide affordable legal education for the people of the Sacramento area; and


