

## RESOLUTION NO. 2008-630

### AGREEMENT WITH THE UNITED STATES OLYMPIC COMMITTEE FOR A PARALYMPIC SPORTS CLUB IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO

#### BACKGROUND

- A. The Paralympic Sport Club is a community-based Paralympic sport development program that is operated by a local administrative agency.
- B. The U. S. Olympic Committee's Paralympics Division provides the opportunity to use Paralympic marks in promoting local programs, and provides the opportunity to co-brand Paralympics with your existing local programs.
- C. The Paralympic Sport Club will provide an excellent opportunity to connect organizations to new audiences, increase sport and physical activity opportunities in the City of Sacramento and raise the profile of Paralympic sport nationally.
- D. The formal agreement between the City of Sacramento and the United States Olympic Committee, Paralympic Division, will bring National recognition and validity to the new Paralympic Sport Sacramento program.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement with the United States Olympic Committee authorizing the City of Sacramento to provide a Paralympic Sport Club Program through the City's Access Leisure Program.




