APPROVING THE REICHMUTH PARK MASTER PLAN CHANGE

BACKGROUND

- A. Reichmuth Park is a 42.1-acre community park located in South Land Park. The changes to the Reichmuth Park Master Plan was reviewed and supported by the Parks and Recreation Commission on August 7, 2008.
- B. The Environmental Services Manager has reviewed the project for compliance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and determined that the project is exempt under Section 15303 of the CEQA Guidelines (Tit. 14 Cal. Code Reg. §15000 et seq.).
- C. Long-term designs of public facilities are reviewed and approved by City Council.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


