---


- Since 1982 SETA has helped over 42,000 refugees resettle and find employment in the Sacramento region
- SETA's Refugee Services program served over 2,445 customers last year
  - English As A Second Language
  - OJT and Vocational Training
  - Social Adjustment services



# **SETA Provides Emergency and Self-Sufficiency Services**

---

- The Community Services Block Grant program improved the lives of over 7,141 youth, seniors, homeless, the disabled, non-custodial parents and other low-income individuals.
- SETA participated in the Voluntary Income Tax Assistance effort
  - 3,177 tax returns completed
  - \$4,675,409 in tax refunds

# SETA Serves Children and Families




- SETA served 7,185 Head Start preschool children and families in 115 child development centers in Sacramento City and County. In addition 850 were served through Early Head Start
  - ✓ 27% are funded in part through the California Department of Education




