

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2008-717**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 6, 2008

### **REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT FOR HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION PROGRAM BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF SACRAMENT AND THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City operates a permanent household hazardous waste collection facility located at the Sacramento Recycling and Transfer Station, 8491 Fruitridge Road, Sacramento, California.
- B. The County owns and operates a permitted permanent household hazardous waste collection facility located at the County's North Area Transfer Station, 4450 Roseville Road, North Highlands, California.
- C. The County owns and operates a permitted Antifreeze, Batteries, Oil, and Paint ("ABOP") Collection Facility located at the County Kiefer Landfill, 12701 Kiefer Boulevard, Sloughhouse, California.
- D. The City and County desire to cooperate in utilizing each other's collection facilities to provide convenient access to County and City residents for their disposal of household hazardous waste and to reimburse each other for the costs incurred at a rate of \$55.00 per car load.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or authorized designee, is authorized to execute the reimbursement agreement between the City and County for an annual amount not to exceed \$100,000.
- Section 2. The agreement provides an option to renew the term for up to four (4) additional one-year terms. The City Manager or authorized designee may authorize such renewals for the annual not to exceed amount specified above, provided that sufficient funds are available in the budget adopted for the applicable Fiscal Year(s).


