APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE STREET SWEEPER

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of General Services, Fleet Management Division has a customer requirement to purchase one street sweeper for the Department of Utilities. This sweeper will be used to maintain streets throughout the City and is a scheduled replacement for older equipment.
- B. In accordance with City Code 3.56.240, the City Manager may, by cooperative purchasing approved by City Council, purchase supplies through contracts of other governmental jurisdictions without separate competitive bidding, where it is advantageous to the City.
- C. Using the existing cooperative purchasing agreement between the Houston-Galveston Area Council (HGAC) (Contract No. SW04-08) to purchase one street sweeper from Schwarze Industries, Inc., is advantageous to the City as the agreement meets the needs of the City's fleet equipment specifications as related to the City's Fleet Sustainability Policy adopted by City Council (Resolution No. 2007-771) on October 23, 2007. This agreement will also result in cost and time savings.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The use of HGAC contract SW04-08 with Schwarze Industries, Inc., is approved for the purchase of one street sweeper, in an amount not to exceed \$225,278.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the necessary purchases in the amount specified above.


