

## RESOLUTION NO. 2008-750

### AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS CITIES AND AGENCIES IN YOLO COUNTY FOR USE OF THE REVERSE 911 EMERGENCY TELEPHONE NOTIFICATION SYSTEM

#### BACKGROUND

- A. The Reverse 911 (R911) Emergency Telephone Notification System was established in May 2005.
- B. In partnership with the regional R911 users, several Yolo County agencies are asking to join the R911 group as a means of providing better service to the residents in Yolo County. These entities are the City of Davis, City of Woodland, Yolo County Office of Emergency Services and Yolo County Emergency Communications Agency.

#### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, is hereby authorized to enter into Memorandums of Understanding which would allow the following entities to access and use the City's Reverse 911 Emergency Telephone Notification System: City of Davis, City of Woodland, Yolo County Office of Emergency Services and Yolo County Emergency Communication Agency.


Adopted by the City of Sacramento City Council on November 18, 2008 by the following vote:
