

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2008-766**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

November 25, 2008

### **APPROVING THE USE OF A COOPERATIVE PURCHASING AGREEMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ELECTRICAL SUPPLIES**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City of Sacramento has ongoing requirements to purchase electrical supplies and through a cooperative purchasing contract with U.S. Communities Purchasing Alliance (U.S. Communities), the City has an opportunity to obtain lower pricing on these items through volume purchasing.
- B. In accordance with City Code 3.56.240, the City Manager may, by cooperative purchasing approved by City Council, purchase supplies through contracts of other governmental jurisdictions without separate competitive bidding, where it is advantageous to the City.
- C. Using the U.S. Communities contract MA-IS-43272-6 to purchase electrical supplies from Graybar Electrical is advantageous to the City as the agreement will result in cost and time savings.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The use of U.S. Communities contract MA-IS-43272-6 with Graybar Electrical is approved for the purchase of electrical supplies, in an amount not to exceed \$750,000 through January 31, 2010 or until the contract is no longer available for use.
- Section 2. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee is authorized to execute the necessary purchases in the amount specified above provided that sufficient funds are available in the budgets adopted for the applicable fiscal years.


