

RESOLUTION NO. 2008-802

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

December 9, 2008

ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY FOR THE 2009 SOBRIETY CHECKPOINT PROGRAM

BACKGROUND

- A. In June 2006 the California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) awarded the City of Sacramento approximately \$900,000 in grant funding to implement a DUI Enforcement and Compliance Team in the City of Sacramento. The term of that two-year grant program expired September 30, 2008.
- B. In January 2008 OTS awarded the Sacramento Police Department \$171,000 in overtime funding to conduct DUI Enforcement and Special Traffic Safety programs. The goal of this program is to augment DUI surveillance and traffic enforcement throughout the City of Sacramento to reduce alcohol-related collisions and injuries. The term of this grant program is October 1, 2008, through September 30, 2009.
- C. In November 2008 OTS awarded the Sacramento Police Department \$145,700 in overtime funding to conduct citywide DUI sobriety checkpoints between October 1, 2008 and September 30, 2009. The grant focuses on conducting checkpoints, especially during the Winter Holiday and Labor Day periods.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Manager of the City of Sacramento, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Sacramento, to accept State of California, Office of Traffic Safety, grant funds in the amount of up to \$145,700 including any extensions or amendments thereof, to implement the 2009 Sobriety Checkpoint Program.
2. The City Manager, or his designated representative, is hereby authorized to adjust the appropriate grant revenue and expenditure budgets to implement the \$145,700 Sobriety Checkpoint Program.


Adopted by the City of Sacramento City Council on December 9, 2008 by the following vote:
