Description/Analysis

Issue: Appointment of Executive Director for the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency.

Policy Considerations: Pursuant to the Sacramento Housing Redevelopment Agency Joint Powers Agreement, the City Manager and County Executive jointly are responsible to recommend an Executive Director to the Governing Boards for approval.


Rationale for Recommendation: La Shelle Dozier has served as Interim Executive Director since January 1, 2008. While serving as Interim Director she participated in a nationwide search for the Executive Director position that collected 57 resumes. The search was conducted by Alliance Resource Consulting. The final candidates were interviewed in-person by three separate interview panels which selected two candidates for final consideration by the City and County. As a result, the City Manager and the County Executive are recommending the appointment of Ms. Dozier to the Executive Director of the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency. Both the City Manager and the County Executive have been impressed with Ms. Dozier's leadership and feel confident that she is the best person to implement the goals and vision of the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency. Ms. Dozier was previously the Director of the Sacramento Housing Authority and Division Manager of the Sacramento Metro Air Quality District.

Financial Considerations: It is recommended that Ms. Dozier be appointed at Step 5 of the Executive Director Salary Range. Funding for this position is included in the approved 2009 Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency budget. The date of the appointment is effective January 13, 2009.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): The items discussed in this report have no M/WBE impact; therefore M/WBE consideration does not apply.
