XANDRIA NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT APPROVAL (S15071133)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) was adopted by City Council in December 1995 and officially began in May 1996.
- B. The Xandria NTMP Project (S15071133) began in February 2008. The project has followed the NTMP guidelines established by Council resolution. Exhibit A identifies project boundaries.
- C. A traffic calming plan has been designed by residents serving on the Traffic Calming Committee and voted on by neighborhood residents with a 90.9% approval rate. Exhibit B (attached) is the ballot.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Xandria NTMP Project (S15071133) is approved.




