

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-136

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

March 10, 2009

APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND AWARD CONTRACT FOR EL CAMINO AVENUE AND COLFAX STREET TRAFFIC SIGNAL (S15074305)

BACKGROUND

- A. Currently, El Camino Avenue and Colfax Street are both two-way streets with one traffic lane in each direction. West El Camino and Colfax was number two on the 2007 Traffic Signal Priority List update to the City's Transportation Programming Guide. This project will install a traffic signal, reconstruct curb ramps to comply with the Americans with Disability Act Standards on all four corners, and new signing and striping.
- B. The project was advertised and bids were received on January 28, 2009. The results are summarized below:

- D. The engineer's estimate is \$188,000. It is recommended that the contract be awarded to Pacific Excavation, Inc.

- Section 1. The Plans and specifications for the El Camino Avenue and Colfax Street Traffic Signal (S15074305) are approved.
- Section 2. The construction contract is awarded to Pacific Excavation, Inc. for an amount not to exceed \$127,754.
- Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute a construction contract for an amount not to exceed \$127,754 with Pacific Excavation, Inc. for the El Camino Avenue and Colfax Street Traffic Signal Project.




