SACRAMENTO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TERMINAL MODERNIZATION PROGRAM (TMP) PUBLIC ART ADMINISTRATION AGREEMENT

BACKGROUND

- A. On March 25, 2008, the Sacramento County Board of Supervisors (Board) approved a total TMP public art budget of \$8 million, including \$5 million for public art; \$1 million for program administration and \$2 million to be held as restricted funds for an endowment to support the Airport Public Art Program in perpetuity.
- B. The \$1 million dollar administration budget will be used to design and implement an art plan for the project, manage the selection of artists, the fabrication and installation of artworks, the creation of an exhibition program and artwork maintenance plan, education and outreach throughout the five year life of the program. Unspent administration contingencies may be used for the commissioning or purchasing of artworks for the Airport.
- C. Administration funding meets with the continuing mission of the Sacramento Metropolitan Arts Commission Art in Public Places Program to expand public experience with visual arts and ensure a high quality Art in Public Places Program.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The Agreement with the County of Sacramento for the administration of the Sacramento International Airport Terminal Modernization Program Public Art Project is approved, and the City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the Agreement.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to establish a capital project for the Sacramento International Airport Modernization Program.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to make the necessary adjustments to project expense and revenue budgets in an amount up to \$1,000,000 for the Sacramento International Airport Terminal Modernization Public Art Project.


