AGREEMENT FOR FIBER OPTIC CABLE MODIFICATION

BACKGROUND

- A. City owns a fiber optic conduit located along the Eastern side of 29th Street from 700 block of 29th street to the Light Rail Station at 29th and R Streets for a total of approximately 5,400 lineal feet of conduit, which is presently not used by the City.
- B. Sacramento Regional Transit District (RT) desires to use the City's conduit to install 48 strands of fiber optic cable to an RT facility. The proposed interagency agreement will allow RT to use the City's existing fiber conduit. In exchange, the City will be given 24 strands of the fiber optic for City's use.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Manager or designee is hereby authorized to execute an interagency agreement with Sacramento Regional Transit District for sharing of the fiber optic communication network resource.
