

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-259

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

AGREEMENT: USE OF TRAINING FACILITIES WITH WESTERN AREA POWER ADMINISTRATION (WAPA)

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento has utilized the training facilities at WAPA for the past two years.
- B. The previous Letter of Agreement, City Contract No. 2008-0027, expired in January 2009.
- C. The use of the training facilities at WAPA is primarily for extensive, ascending (climbing) training scenarios that are involved with the safe access to, and ascension of, high voltage electrical transmission towers. This type of training is necessary to meet the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) mandates, as well as develops the knowledge, skills & abilities of the Sacramento Fire Department personnel to operate in these high risk, low frequency events.
- D. WAPA, has not, and will not charge the City of Sacramento for the use of their training facilities.
- E. The proposed Letter of Agreement provides for an initial term of 1 year, and at the end of this term, it may be extended if both parties mutually agree.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement with WAPA for an initial term of 1 year and up to 4 additional 1 year extensions, for a possible total term of 5 years.


