## Recognizing the 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Sacramento Regional Conservation Corps (SRCC)

**WHEREAS**, the Sacramento Regional Conservation Corps (SRCC) was founded by the Sacramento Metro Chamber of Commerce in 1984; and

**WHEREAS**, the SRCC is celebrating 25 years of service to young adults 18 – 25 years of age by providing a development program integrating education, job skills training and paid work experience on conservation projects and through service opportunities that benefit the region and the corpsmembers; and


**WHEREAS**, over 4,500 young adults have moved through the Corps' program during this period, many of whom have attained a GED and / or high school diploma from the Sacramento Regional Conservation Corps campus of the John Muir Charter School and have left the Corps for progressive and gainful employment in the community; and


**WHEREAS**, during the past 25 years over 1.5 million hours of conservation and environmental services have been provided in the region by the corpsmembers. Each year over 321,000 linear feet of creeks are cleared of debris and vegetation overgrowth and 4,000 school children are annually presented information about recycling and homes have been weatherized for energy efficiency; and


**WHEREAS**, Breakfast on the River fundraiser is in its twelfth year raising needed funds for the Corpsmember Education and Career Development Fund.






