WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these services, as well as their planning, design, and construction, are reliant upon the efforts and skills of public works employees; and


WHEREAS, one of the goals of National Public Works Week is to increase confidence in public works employees, who are committed to improving the quality of life for present and future generations; and


