

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-309

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

EL MONTE NEIGHBORHOOD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROGRAM PROJECT APPROVAL (S15071128)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (NTMP) was adopted by City Council in December 1995 and officially began in May 1996.
- B. The El Monte NTMP Project (S15071128) began in February 2008. The project has followed the NTMP guidelines established by Council resolution. Exhibit A identifies project boundaries.
- C. A traffic calming plan has been designed by residents serving on the Traffic Calming Committee and voted on by neighborhood residents with a 60% approval rate. Exhibit B (attached) is the ballot.
- D. The El Monte NTMP Project (S15071128) will include an accessibility gate on the existing sidewalk. The gate will allow pedestrian and wheelchair access, but prevent motorcycles from using the sidewalk as a cut-through.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The El Monte NTMP Project (S15071128) is approved.

Section 2. The FY08/09 Capital Improvement Program Budget is amended by transferring \$5,000 from the Neighborhood Traffic Management Program (S15071100) to the El Monte NTMP Project (S15071128).







Do you want traffic calming measures in your neighborhood?

You have the opportunity to vote on a traffic calming plan for your neighborhood. This vote is to determine if the measures recommended by the Traffic Calming Committee (TCC), which consists of residents from your neighborhood, will be implemented.

The TCC assisted city staff in developing the plan. Various measures were reviewed and agreed upon by the TCC.

Your Vote Counts!

Every address (residence and business) within your neighborhood has received this notice and ballot. Now is your opportunity to vote for or against the proposed traffic calming measures.

You and your neighbors will decide whether or not the traffic calming measures will be implemented in your neighborhood.

If enough votes are in favor, the plan will be presented to City Council for review, final approval and funding. In order to pass, a minimum of 25% of all ballots must be returned with a simple majority in favor of the plan.

Proposed Measures for Your Neighborhood

Below are the recommended measures. If approved, the measures will be constructed at no cost to residents and /or homeowners. You are asked to vote in favor of or against the entire traffic calming plan which includes the following measures:

Speed Lumps - Install on:

- Colfax St between Arden Wy & El Monte Av
- Edgewater Rd, north of the alley between Arden Wy and Del Paso Bl.

Traffic Island - Install a pork-chop shaped island in the NE portion of the intersection of El Monte Av & Colfax St.

Crosswalk - Install a crosswalk on the east side of Colfax St across El Monte Av.

Accessibility Gate - Install a gate east of the bollards on the sidewalk on the SE side of the El Monte Av cul-de-sac.

Landscape Boulders - Place large landscaping rocks in the planter area at the end of the cul-de-sac.

Raised Curb - Install raised curb on the existing painted island on Edgewater Rd, south of Arden Wy.

Center Median - Install a raised median over the existing centerline on the north end of Edgewater Rd approaching Arden Wy.

"No Outlet" Signs - Install reflective "No Outlet" signs on Dale Av north of El Monte Av and on El Monte Av east of Dale Av.
