**APPROVING THE SOUTHSIDE PARK PICNIC AREA RENOVATION
CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (CIP L19162104)**

BACKGROUND

- A. Southside Park is an existing 19.5 acre community park located at 2115 6th Street in Community Planning Area 1 Central City.
- B. As stated in City Council Resolution No. 2007-404 Section 10.2, City Council approval is required to establish Capital Improvement Program (CIP) projects.
- C. In resolution number 2008-066, City Council approved the application for the Land and Conservation Fund Program grant, establish budgets, and approve the receipt of funds once the grant was awarded.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. A new CIP for Southside Park Picnic Area Renovation is established as L19162104 in the amount of \$142,985. Matching funds of \$142,985 will come from the City of Sacramento's Park Impact Fee (PIF) Fund 3204.


