

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-337

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

May 26, 2009

DEFENSE ENERGY SUPPORT CENTER (DESC) AVIATION FUEL CONTRACT

BACKGROUND

- A. The Defense Energy Support Center (DESC) provides aviation fuels to Law Enforcement agencies at military pricing. The SPD has maintained an agreement with DESC for the past several years and they have been a consistent and dependable source of discounted fuel. DESC requires a written agreement with contracting law enforcement agencies that is renewable yearly.
- B. It is in the City's best interest to suspend competitive bidding to enter an agreement with DESC for the purchase of aviation fuel in an amount not to exceed \$625,000 because (1) pricing under the contract with DESC is less than half of the retail fuel prices, creating substantial savings for the City and (2) the Police Department's Air Support Unit plays a critical role in the SPD's law enforcement function.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. In the best interests of the City, competitive bidding is hereby suspended for the purchase of aviation fuel.
- Section 2. The contract for the purchase of aviation fuel is awarded to Defense Energy Support Center (DESC) for an amount not to exceed \$125,000 for the initial term through May 2010, with options by DESC to extend from year to year.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to enter into extensions of the contract with DESC for four additional one-year terms in an annual amount not to exceed \$125,000 if DESC exercises its options to extend the contract, provided that sufficient funds are available in the budget adopted for the applicable Fiscal Year(s).




