

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-349

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 2, 2009

APPROVING A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR 4TH "R" SHADE STRUCTURES (L19803100)

BACKGROUND

- A. The 4th "R" Shade Structures project consists of the installation of shade structures at nine 4th "R" facilities located at various elementary schools throughout Sacramento.
- B. As stated in City Council Resolution No. 2008-423 Section 10.2, City Council approval is required to establish Capital Improvement Program projects.
- C. The proposed project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the following sections of the CEQA Guidelines (Title 14 Cal. Code Reg. § 15000 et seq.): Section 15061(b)(3) (where it can be seen with certainty that there is not possibility that the activity in question may have a significant impact on the environment, the activity is not subject to CEQA); Section 15303(c) (construction and location of limited numbers of new, small facilities or structures, such as accessory (appurtenant) structures); Section 15311 (construction of minor structures accessory to (appurtenant to) existing institutional facilities; and Section 15314 (minor additions to existing schools.)

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. A new Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for 4th "R" Shade Structures is established as L19803100.
- Section 2. That \$175,000 from the 4th "R" Fund, Fund 6012, is appropriated for L19803100.




