

# RESOLUTION NO. 2009-351

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 2, 2009

## APPROVING THE CHORLEY PARK MASTER PLAN UPDATE (L19808500)

### BACKGROUND

- A. The public's perception of the safety of parks and recreation facilities has declined since 2003 according to two public surveys of residents within the City of Sacramento.
- B. On April 10, 2008, the City Council adopted the *Parks and Recreation Safety Implementation Plan (PSIP)*. As part of the *PSIP*, the City Council approved action plans for nine City parks to implement capital improvements and operational enhancements to make these parks positive, clean, vibrant and safe environments for park users.
- C. On December 9, 2008, the City Council adopted the *Section 5: Financing of the Parks and Recreation Safety Implementation Plan (PSIP)* including the recommendations contained therein related to a "premier level" standard for *PSIP* projects.
- D. Chorley Park is a 32.5 acre community park located in the South Area on 7063 20th Street. The Chorley Park Master Plan Update was reviewed and supported by the Parks and Recreation Commission on February 5, 2009.
- E. The City of Sacramento, Environmental Planning Services has determined that the Chorley Park Master Plan project, as proposed, will not have a significant impact to the environment; therefore a Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared. In compliance with Section 15070(b)(1) of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines, the City has incorporated mandatory mitigation measures into the project plans to avoid identified impacts or to mitigate such impacts to a point where clearly no significant impacts will occur. These mitigation measures are included in the attached Mitigation Reporting Plan and address impacts to cultural resources.
- F. The Mitigated Negative Declaration was available for public review during the period of April 7, 2009 through May 6, 2009. Staff recommends that the City Council approve the Mitigated Negative Declaration and adopt the Mitigated Monitoring Plan for the Chorley Park Master Plan Project.
- G. Long-term designs of public facilities are reviewed and approved by City Council.

### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Chorley Park Master Plan Update is approved.




