BACKGROUND

- A. The California Emergency Management Services' Project Safe Neighborhood/Anti-Gang Initiative Program provides funding to local law enforcement agencies for public safety purposes.
- B. The Police Department plans to utilize this funding to fully investigate all gun-related violent crimes.


