

# RESOLUTION NO. 2009-403

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

June 16, 2009

## DETERMINING PROJECT EXEMPT FROM REVIEW UNDER CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT (P09-004)

### BACKGROUND

- A. On March 12, 2009, the City Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on and approved with conditions the Mueller Pet Hospital Signage Project.
- B. On March 23, 2009, the project applicant filed a timely appeal of the Planning Commission's action to the City Council.
- C. On June 16, 2009, the City Council conducted a public hearing, for which notice was given pursuant Sacramento City Code Section 17.200.010(C)(2)(a), (b), and (c), and received and considered evidence concerning the Mueller Pet Hospital Signage Project Appeal.

### BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1     Based on the determination and recommendation of the City's Environmental Planning Services Manager and the oral and documentary evidence received at the hearing on the Project, the City Council finds that the Project is exempt from review under Section 15311 - Accessory Structures of the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines as follows:

Section 15311 consists of the construction or replacement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial facilities, such as on-premises signs. The proposed project consists of the construction of on-premise signs accessory to the existing commercial facilities.


