Recommendation: Adopt a **Resolution** authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to execute an Interagency Agreement between the City and the County of Sacramento for the transfer of components of the City's decommissioned mainframe computer hardware system to the County in exchange for backup data recovery support for a period of two years.

Description/Analysis

Issue: On March 31, 2009, the City's mainframe computer system was decommissioned. All of the hardware components of this system are now considered to be surplus property. The County of Sacramento (County) uses a similar mainframe computer system and is interested in acquiring several of the City's surplus mainframe components.

This report recommends executing an Interagency Agreement between the City and County that will transfer surplus mainframe computer hardware components from the City to the County in exchange for the County providing backup data

recovery support to the City.

Policy Considerations: The recommendation in this report is in accordance with the provisions of City Code Chapter 3.80.

Committee/Commission Action: Not applicable

Environmental Considerations:

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA): This report concerns administrative activities that will not have a significant effect on the environment, and does not constitute a "project" as defined by CEQA.

Sustainability Considerations: Not applicable

Rationale for Recommendation: The recommended Interagency Agreement between the City and the County will benefit both agencies. The City will secure backup computer data recovery support and the County will acquire backup computer hardware components.

The City has a need for backup computer data recovery support for the next two years in the event that data recovery is needed from the decommissioned mainframe computer system. The City has received a quote of \$20,000 for the two year period for this service from IBM. The City's surplus components have an estimated value \$18,000. The County is willing to provide this support for the two year period in exchange for the City's surplus mainframe computer components.

Financial Considerations: This report does not result in any financial impact to the City.

Emerging Small Business Development (ESBD): No goods or services are being purchased as a result of this report.



**INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT FOR THE TRANSFER OF MAINFRAME COMPUTER
HARDWARE COMPONENTS**

BACKGROUND

- A. The City's mainframe computer system was decommissioned on March 31, 2009.
- B. The City has a need for backup computer data recovery support for the next two years in the event that data recovery is needed from the decommissioned mainframe computer system. The County is willing to provide this support for the two year period in exchange for components of the City's surplus mainframe computer system.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or the City Manager's designee are hereby authorized to execute an Interagency Agreement between the City and the County of Sacramento for the transfer of components of the City's decommissioned mainframe computer hardware system to the County in exchange for backup computer data recovery support for a period of two years.
