APPROVING A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION FOR RECRUITMENT AND MANAGEMENT OF STUDENT INTERNS (15001111)

BACKGROUND

- A. The Department of Transportation has a need for temporary administrative and technical support, and the use of student interns provides flexibility in meeting service demand levels. The student intern program through Community College Foundation (CCF) provides valuable training and experience that has enabled many student interns to become City employees.
- B. A Request for Qualifications (RFQ) was advertised April 2009, and CCF was the only qualified firm to respond. The Department of Transportation has had multiple contracts with CCF over the past five years and the student intern program administered by CCF continues to be a cost-effective means of obtaining temporary administrative and technical support.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Professional Services Agreement with Community College Foundation for Recruitment and Management of Student Interns for a period of one (1) year for an annual not-to-exceed amount of \$397,000.




