

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-448

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

DISADVANTAGE BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE) PROGRAM GOALS AND AGREEMENT FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2009-2010

BACKGROUND

- A. The City of Sacramento has received and expects to continue to receive federal financial assistance through the State of California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) for Federal Fiscal Year 2009-2010, commencing October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.
- B. As a condition of receiving this assistance, the City of Sacramento must adopt annual the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goals and execute the DBE Program Implementation Agreement by August 1, 2009.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City of Sacramento hereby reaffirms its commitment to comply with the State of California Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program and Implementation Agreement for the purpose of receiving federal financial assistance from Caltrans for transportation projects.
- Section 2. The City Council hereby adopts for the City of Sacramento an Annual Anticipation DBE Participation Level (AADPL) goal of 23.8% for federal FY 2009/2010, consisting of a minimum 17.2% race-conscious and 6.6% race-neutral participation levels based on the analysis set out in Exhibit B.
- Section 3. The City Council hereby approves the DBE Program Implementation Agreement as set out in Exhibit A and the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement and related documents required for the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise Program for the Federal Fiscal Year 2009-2010, effective October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010.


