

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009-452**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

July 14, 2009

### **GRANT: CALIFORNIA TASK FORCE SEVEN (CA TF-7), URBAN SEARCH AND RESCUE (US&R) TASK FORCE RESPONSE TO NORTH DAKOTA FLOOD (G12701800)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The City of Sacramento Fire Department has been the sponsoring agency for CA TF-7, US&R task force since the inception of the Federal Urban Search & Rescue program in the early 1990's. CA TF-7 has responded for emergency assistance to the bombing of the Federal Murrah building in Oklahoma City, the terrorist attack of the World Trade Center in New York, to the Gulf Coast in the aftermath of Hurricane Katrina and various other events.
- B. CA TF-7 can be deployed as an entire task force, or individual members, to provide overhead support to man-made and natural disasters; and national special security events.
- C. On March 27, 2009, two (2) members of CA TF-7 were activated by the Department of Homeland Security/Federal Emergency Management Agency (DHS/FEMA) for response to North Dakota Floods.
- D. To receive reimbursement for costs associated with the deployment of personnel to North Dakota Floods, the City must adopt a resolution granting signature authority for the City Manager to sign the DHS/FEMA Assistance Award/Amendment EMW-2008-CA-1498, Amendment M004.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute the agreement (EMW-2008-CA-1498, Amendment M004) to accept the federal funding for California Task Force Seven (CA TF-7), Urban Search and Rescue Task Force (US&R), in the amount of \$56,000.
- Section 2. An operating grant shall be established for the CA TF-7 US&R North Dakota Flood Deployment (G12701800).
- Section 3. A revenue and expenditure budget in the amount of \$56,000 shall be established for the CA TF-7 US&R North Dakota Flood Deployment (G12701800).


