ACCEPTANCE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2009-2013 RECOVERY ACT: EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT FORMULA PROGRAM: LOCAL SOLICITATION

BACKGROUND

- A. On March 6, 2009, President Obama announced the allocation of \$2 billion in funds from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act.
- B. The Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Formula Program: Local Solicitation (Recovery Act JAG), administered through the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance, allows state and local governments to support a broad range of activities to prevent and control crime and to improve the criminal justice system. Two primary purposes specific to the Recovery Act JAG are (1) to preserve and create jobs and promote economic recovery, and (2) to stabilize state and local government budgets. Forty percent of the Recovery JAG funding is designated for units of local government.
- C. On July 30, 2009, the City of Sacramento Police Department was awarded \$2,527,660 in Recovery Act JAG funding.
- D. The grant performance period for the Recovery Act JAG is four years, March 1, 2009, through February 28, 2013.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to accept, including any necessary certifications, on behalf of the City of Sacramento, for a minimum base allocation of \$2,527,660 in Recovery Act: Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Formula Program: Local Solicitation funding from the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance.
- Section 2. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to establish a grant project for the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Formula Program.
- Section 3. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to adjust the necessary grant revenue and expenditure budgets to implement the \$2,527,660 grant.




