AWARD CONTRACT FOR SOUTH LAND PARK WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT – PHASE 4 (Z14010011)

BACKGROUND

- A. The existing water distribution system in the South Land Park area is deteriorated beyond rehabilitation. In order to improve reliability and health and safety, City Council approved the South Land Park Steel Water Main Replacement Project, Phase 4 (Z14010011) budget in fiscal year 2009/2010.
- B. City staff prepared a set of plans and specifications to construct 14,800 lineal feet of water distribution mains complete with new water services, water meters, and fire hydrants.
- C. The project was advertised for bidding and bids were received on August 12th, 2009. The low bid submitted by Evan Brothers was nonresponsive, because Evan Brothers' bid failed to acknowledge receipt of the bid addendum as required and did not meet the minimum ESBD participation requirement of 20%.
- D. United Building Contractors was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract plans and specifications for the South Land Park Water Main Replacement – Phase 4 (Z14010011) are approved, and the contract is awarded to United Building Contractors, for an amount not to exceed \$1,628,656.




