

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009-589**

### **AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE SAFE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT WATER METER RETROFIT PROJECT PHASE 2 (Z14010000)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. On August 6, 2009, the City Council approved Resolution 2009-516 authorizing the execution of a \$ 20 Million grant/loan funding agreement for the Water Meter Retrofit (WMR) Project (Phases 1-10), utilizing American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding provided through the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF) Program administered by the California Department of Public Health.
- B. The WMR Project will retrofit water services with meters at a total of 11,000 - 13,000 residential and commercial properties, and Phase 2 of the Project will install 1,650 meters on unmetered services.
- C. The plans and specifications for Phase 2 of the Project were approved by the City Council on June 23, 2009.
- D. Bids for Phase 2 of the Project were opened on August 26, 2009, and Florez Paving was the lowest responsible bidder.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The contract for the SDWSRF ARRA Water Meter Retrofit Project Phase 2 is awarded to Florez Paving for an amount not to exceed \$1,784,648.


