Comments: A correction has been made to the bid summary chart on page 8 of the report to reduce the low bidder's MBE/WBE/DBE participation %, because a minority-owned subcontractor listed by the low bidder does not qualify as a DBE per applicable EPA requirements.

This contract (Phase 8) will install 946 meters on unmetered residential and commercial services within the project area (see Attachment 1).

All retrofit projects are coordinated with public outreach to customers and stake holders.

This project was advertised on August 10, 2009 and eight (8) bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on September 2, 2009. The bids are summarized below:

The engineer's estimate was \$ 1,790,000

Staff recommends the contract be awarded to Marques Pipeline, Inc., the lowest responsible bidder for an amount not to exceed \$1,255,558.

Staff also recommends adopting the attached Resolution approving the plans and specifications for Phase 11 of the ARRA Water Meter Retrofit Project, and authorizing an amendment to the City's Funding Agreement with the California Department of Public Health to add Phase 11 to the ARRA Water Meter Retrofit Project. Adding Phase 11 will allow the City to utilize the ARRA funding to install additional water meters if sufficient ARRA funding remains after awarding contracts for Phases 1-10, which may occur if the low bids for Phases 9 and 10 come in below the engineer's cost estimates.
