**APPROVAL TO SUBMIT HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (HSIP) APPLICATION FOR 12<sup>TH</sup> STREET CORRIDOR PROJECT**

**BACKGROUND**

- A. Caltrans has issued a call for projects for the federal Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). Funds are available to solve safety problems on transportation facilities. Funding available for the 2009/10 Federal Fiscal Year is approximately \$50-million statewide. Staff recommendation is to submit an application for 12<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor to provide coordination, pre-emption, and communication to light rail transit.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City manager is authorized to submit an application for funding to the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) for the 12<sup>th</sup> Street Corridor in the amount of \$900,000.



