

## RESOLUTION NO. 2009-631

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

October 13, 2009

### 2008 CALIFORNIA REDUCTION, INTERVENTION AND PREVENTION PROGRAM

#### BACKGROUND

- A. The purpose of the California Gang Reduction, Intervention and Prevention Program (CalGRIP) is to provide grants to cities for gang prevention, intervention, reentry, education, job training and skills development, family and community services, and suppression activities.
- B. The Office of Youth Development staff will engage local schools, non-profits, faith-based, city and non-city entities to foster a comprehensive and multi-disciplinary approach to eliminating youth and gang violence.
- C. The proposed project will primarily focus on a combination of recidivism prevention, school reentry and education, job training, and community services, including referrals to employment, substance abuse and mental health services.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager or designee is authorized to accept \$400,000 in federal grant funding through the California Emergency Management Agency's 2008 Gang Reduction, and Prevention Program (CalGRIP)
- Section 2. The City Manager or designee is authorized to establish a new grant project for the CalGRIP grant (G19001100).
- Section 3. The City Manager or designee is authorized to establish a \$400,000 revenue and expenditure budget (Fund: 2702) within the CalGRIP grant project.
- Section 4. The City Manager or designee is authorized to establish the necessary revenue and expense budgets (Fund 2703) within the CalGrip Grant, Office of Youth Development , Department of Parks and Recreation, and Kaiser Street Outreach Grant to fund the \$400,000 grant match requirement
- Section 5. The City Manager or designee is authorized to enter into agreements or contracts with program partners, as needed to implement the Youth Violence Recidivism Reduction Project


