AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE SAFE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT WATER METER RETROFIT PROJECT PHASE 7 (PN: Z14010000) BACKGROUND

- A. On August 6, 2009, the City Council approved Resolution 2009-516 authorizing the execution of a \$20 Million grant/loan funding agreement for the Water Meter Retrofit (WMR) Project (Phases 1-9), utilizing American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding provided through the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF) Program administered by the California Department of Public Health. The City Council approved the addition of additional Phases to the Project on September 15 (Phase 10) and September 22 (Phase 11).
- B. The WMR Project will retrofit water services with meters at approximately 15,000 to 17,000 residential and commercial properties, and Phase 7 of the Project will install 1,955 meters on unmetered services.
- C. The plans and specifications for Phase 7 of the Project were approved by the City Council on June 23, 2009.
- D. Bids for Phase 7 of the Project were opened on September 16, 2009 and Florez Paving was the lowest responsible bidder.

BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The contract for the SDWSRF ARRA Water Meter Retrofit Project Phase 7 is awarded to Florez Paving, for an amount not to exceed \$2,029,785.


