

## **RESOLUTION NO. 2009-647**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

### **AWARD CONTRACT FOR THE SAFE DRINKING WATER STATE REVOLVING FUND AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT WATER METER RETROFIT PROJECT PHASE 10 (Z14010000)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. On August 6, 2009, the City Council approved Resolution 2009-516 authorizing the execution of a \$ 20 Million grant/loan funding agreement for the Water Meter Retrofit (WMR) Project (Phases 1-9), utilizing American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) funding provided through the Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (SDWSRF) Program administered by the California Department of Public Health. The City Council approved the addition of additional Phases to the Project on September 15 (Phase 10) and September 22 (Phase 11).
- B. The WMR Project will retrofit water services with meters at a total of 15,000 - 17,000 residential and commercial properties, and Phase 10 of the Project will install 2,191 meters on unmetered services.
- C. The plans and specifications for Phase 10 of the Project were approved by the City Council on September 15, 2009.
- D. Bids for Phase 10 of the Project were opened on September 23, 2009, and Advantage Demolition & Engineering was the lowest responsible bidder. The low bid submitted by Advantage Demolition & Engineering included several irregularities in attachments that were included in the ARRA bid requirements, as described in the staff report for this item. These constitute minor irregularities that are hereby waived because they do not have any relationship to the bid price, and obtaining the required information from Advantage Demolition & Engineering and its subcontractors after bid opening does not provide it with any advantage over the other bidders.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The contract for the SDWSRF ARRA Water Meter Retrofit Project Phase 10 is awarded to Advantage Demolition & Engineering, for an amount not to exceed \$2,230,779.




