### **MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING: SACRAMENTO RIVER WATERSHED SANITARY SURVEY UPDATE (Z14000600)**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. The California Surface Water Treatment Rule requires the completion of an update to the Sacramento River Watershed Sanitary Survey by December 2010.
- B. City staff has worked with six other municipal water purveyors to develop a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that provides a cost effective approach to partner together to complete the watershed sanitary survey update requirement.
- C. The MOU regarding contracting and apportionment of costs for a sanitary survey update of the Sacramento River watershed area and follow-up activities has been approved by the six other participating agencies.
- D. The City's share of the watershed sanitary survey update is for an amount not to exceed \$38,000, which includes services in addition to the cost shared work.

#### **BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

- Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Roseville, City of West Sacramento, City of Woodland, East Bay Municipal Utility District, Placer County Water Agency, and Sacramento County Water Agency for the purpose of sharing costs of the 2010 update to the Sacramento River Watershed Sanitary Survey, for a total project cost not to exceed \$200,000, and to provide the option for participating agencies to share costs of follow-up activities on a voluntary basis.


